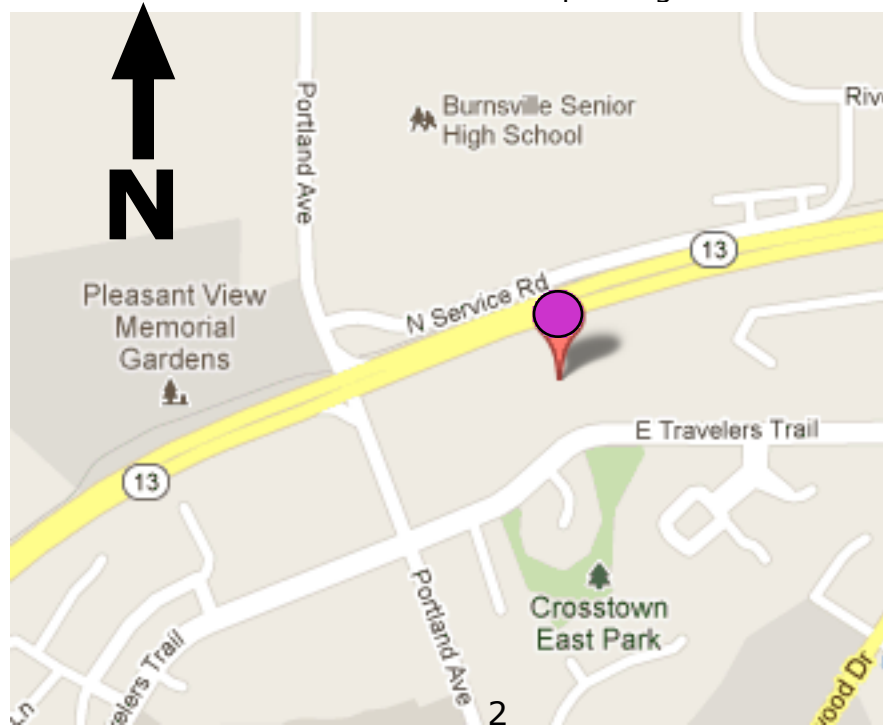

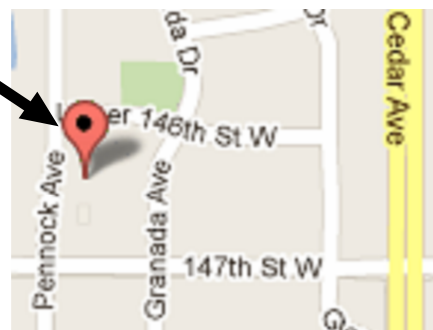

Important Event Notes & Rules:

- * All ASCA show rules and regulations apply.
- * Entries on official ASCA forms only. ASCA entry forms can be downloaded at www.asca.org/formsandrulebooks
- * No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA conformation program, a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs, or a person not in good standing with ASCA.
- * All Aussies over six (6) months of age may be asked to show proof of ASCA registration. Be prepared to present registration papers on all dogs six (6) months of age or older as of the date of this event.
- * All dogs may be asked to show proof of rabies vaccination. In that event, a certificate from a certified veterinarian is required.
- * Any dog that displays viciousness toward people or animals at any time while on the show premises will be ejected from the show site for the entire show weekend with no refund of entries.
- * Physical abuse of any animal will not be tolerated. Any person on the show site reported to have physically abused an animal will be ejected from the show site for the entire show weekend with no refund of entries, and they will be subject to disciplinary action per ASCA rules.
- * No puppies less than eight (8) weeks of age are allowed on the show site. Absolutely no puppy sales allowed on the show grounds.
- * MASC, its Board of Director, ASCA, its Board of Directors, and the show site property owner assume no responsibility or any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs, personal property and/or children.
- * Training on the show site grounds is prohibited.
- * Dogs must be on leash at all times.
- * Do not leave unattended dogs on grooming tables.
- * Show site building will open daily at 8:00 am, and will close one hour after conclusion of show.
